
## Black and White Keys







DOT GAME (Make sure your dots are "removable")

This is not a Fun Sheet for the children. This is a game played to solidify finger colors. Have children walk along keyboard, call out a finger color, then "Ready, Set, tap tap tap tap tap". Then move to the next position, call out a finger color.....repeat as many times as necessary depending on number of children playing the game.

The reason for this drawing is to show you that each color needs to "sound good" with all the other keys of that color.





Taking the green dot as an example, one dot is to the right of the "two black keys." Feel free to put it on the key to the right of either of the other sets of two black keys and it will still sound great with the other two marked keys.

At first just do this game with the right or left hand alone and only with the colors. If the children are already dealing with finger numbers you can also review them by saying, "Right hand green finger....and that is finger number what?"
