
Game Keyboards From Anybody Can Play PIANO app www.anybodycanplay.com

Finding one's way around a piano keyboard requires the ability to recognize the pattern of black and white keys.

These drawings of partial keyboards can be used many ways.

- Laminate and cut apart enough for all the children. Make a sample with colored marks or removable stickers on some keys and have the children duplicate the sample with their markers or stickers.
- 2. Use as a paper FunSheet....again color coding a sample and having the children duplicate the sample.
- 3. Color code keys to match the dots on the keyboard in the Anybody Can Play PIANO app for a given song. This can be done as a group activity as well as an individual activity.
- 4. Have several keyboards already color coded in different ways and have the children pick keyboards that are alike. The small keyboards work well for this activity.
- 5. Touch particular key(s) with particular finger(s);
- 6. Let the children make up some games.
