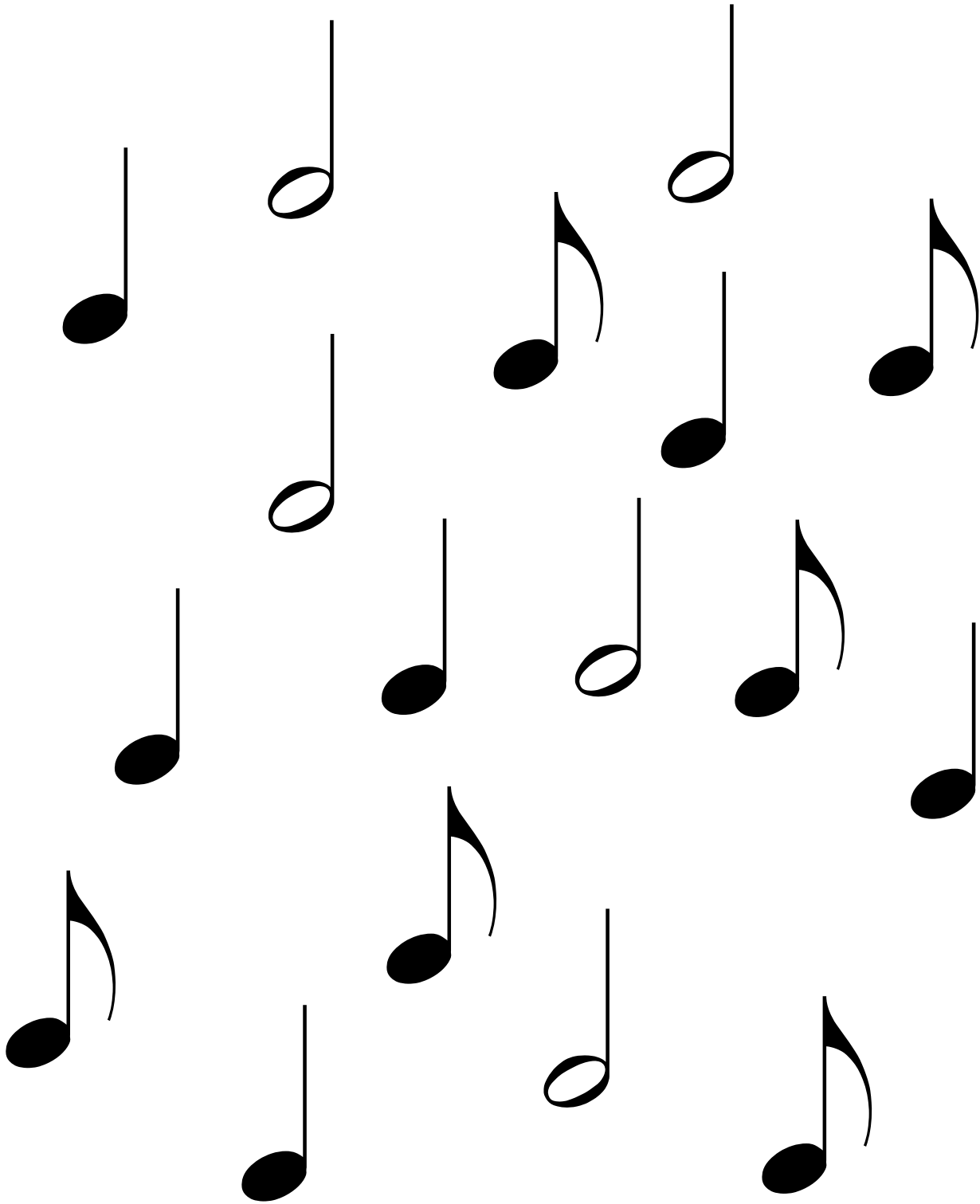
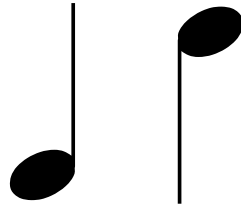


# Find and Circle those Quarter Notes

It usually has only one beat.


That squished round part is called a note head. It looks more like a foot! Remember, notes can be upside down.

That line is called a stem. Just think of a flower on top of its stem and you will remember the name.


Quarter notes can be right side up or upside down in music.
