






## cards for card Match Game

## DIRECTIONS for CARD/MATCH GAME

Notes are seen in music in 8 different ways as seen on the "large" note cards:

Line note right side up

Line note upside down

Space note right side up with line on top of note head

Space note upside down with line on top of note head

Space note right side up with line on bottom of note head

Space note upside down with line on bottom of note head

Space note right side up with line on top and bottom of note head

Space note upside down with line on top and bottom of note head

With this game, the "Leader" shows one of the larger cards and the players try to find a match on their card, then cover the note with a small object (like a Lego block, button, or...) to show there was a match.

There are 2 playing cards per sheet. The two cards on each sheet actually utilize the same set of notes so by using the cards from only one sheet for the game, everyone will "finish" at the same time - just like on the youtube video game.

Paste a colored paper on the back side of the playing card sheet, then cut apart and laminate. Be sure laminate extends around card so card is durable and waterproof. If you paste a different colored sheet on the back side of the 6 different game card sheets you can play the game with everyone "finishing" at the same time by using the same colored game sheets or play with different "finishing" times by playing with different colored game sheets.

Cut larger cards apart and laminate - again making sure laminate extends around all edges.
