







DRIVE AROUND THAT A

Many young children have not had a lot of experience with letters - less drawing them. This is an exercise to solidify recognition of the letter A - and actually give them some experience tracing around the A in order to learn how to write the letter themselves.

Use the plain A or the one with the arrows.

Cut off along top line.

Laminate.

Cut around each car and laminate within a credit card pouch.

Start driving from the top red star.

Drive down along the left side to the bottom.

Go back to the red star.

Drive down along the right side to the bottom.

Now go to the pink dotted line. Starting on the left side drive all the way over to the right side.

It is a good idea to go through the instructions while having them watch you doing the driving, then go through the instructions again with the kids.
